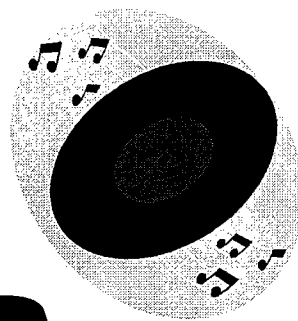
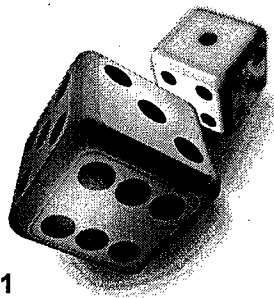
- 1 pkg. frozen hash browns

Day 1

Depart from Martinsburg Bank and Trust locations and enjoy doughnuts and juice as we begin our journey. We'll stop for lunch on your own at the "home of throwed rolls", **Lambert's**, before arriving at the Tennessee Welcome Center in downtown Memphis to meet our guide for a three hour **Memphis City Tour**.

Memphis, the Gateway to the Old South is one of the most beautiful cities in the southern United States. This tour will take you to the **Mississippi Riverfront** and through **downtown Memphis** where tradition and modern progress collide to form an exciting modern city filled with historic sites, fun and adventure. **Sites include Harbor Town, the first residential community built on the Mississippi in the last 100 years; Mud Island; the Pyramid; Historic Cotton Row; Beale Street; Elvis' first home in Memphis and the Lauderdale Courts.** This tour will make a special stop at the **South's Grand Hotel, the Peabody, to view the "March of the Peabody Ducks" and at the Danny Thomas Pavilion at St. Jude's Hospital.**

We'll then head to our home for the next two nights, **Hollywood Casino and Hotel** in Tunica. Dinner at your leisure this evening at the Hollywood Casino buffet. After dinner, relax or try your luck in the casino with the promotional coupon from Hollywood Casino or visit neighboring casinos Harrah's, Sam's Town and Gold Strike. **(B,D)**

Day 2

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel before departing for our "**platinum tour**" of **Graceland**, the mansion home of Elvis Presley. The audio-guided tour includes stories told by Lisa Marie and Elvis. A highlight of the mansion is Elvis' trophy building, which houses his enormous collection of gold records and awards, along with an extensive display of career mementos, stage costumes, jewelry, photographs and much more. End the tour with a quiet visit to the Meditation Garden, where Elvis and other family members have been laid to rest.

Graceland Platinum Tour includes audio-guided tour of Graceland Mansion and grounds and self guided tours of Elvis' two custom airplanes; automobile museum; Hollywood Exhibit; "Elvis Lives: The King and Pop Culture Exhibit"; Private Presley Exhibit; '68 Special Exhibit.

We'll stop for lunch at **Neely's BBQ** and then on to the Welcome Center to complete our city tour. Begin with the **Main Historic District, the Lorraine Motel/National Civil Rights Museum, Victorian Village, Stax Slavehaven, Overton Park, Rhodes College and the campus of the University of Memphis.** Next is a tour of **Sun Studio**, the most famous recording studio in the world, where the blending of blues and country music came together in the big bang of Rock 'n Roll. Relive the musical careers launched here such as Johnny Cash, BB King, Charlie Rich, Jerry Lee Lewis, Elvis Presley and many more! Then it's back to Tunica for dinner on your own and an evening with Lady Luck. **(B,L)**

Day 3

Check out and breakfast at our hotel. We'll have one last stop in Memphis as we visit the **Pink Palace Museum** before we head for home. **(B)**
